CAMPSITE ETIQUETTE GUIDE

You will be expected to follow the following campsite etiquette guide at all times while on camp:

- 1. Follow all posted campsite rules.
- 2. Drinking water taps should only be used for collecting water, they are NOT to be used for washing pots, brushing teeth etc.
- 3. All rubbish should be disposed of at the designated refuse point in a promptly manner and not left outside tents overnight.
- 4. Be respectful and considerate of other campsite users.
- 5. Noise should be kept to a reasonable level at all times. Quiet time begins at 9pm unless stated otherwise by the campsite rules.
- 6. All participants should be in their designated tents by 10.30pm at the latest.
- 7. Any playground equipment will have age restrictions which must be followed.
- 8. No swearing while on site, there may be young children present. Please always be aware of people around you and keep conversations appropriate.
- 9. Clothes should only be dried either in the sun or in designated drying rooms, NOT in the toilets/showers or pot wash.
- 10. Tents must be pitched at least 3m apart to reduce fire risk.
